The car, a **1996 Honda Accord** in great condition, was donated by a **community member who is wishing to remain anonymous**. Once the donation was received, **Genna Eaton, WNC Executive Director** reached out to several businesses in the area for help with some minor

repairs needed, and was amazed at the generous outpouring of assistance that was received. **Troy Meffert of Meffert Oil**, and **Dale Chitek, Meffert's Service Manager** coordinated the service work for WNC, providing the initial diagnostic work as well as the installation of two seat belts and a muffler that needed to be replaced. **Rick Kessenich of Weaver Auto Parts** donated the muffler. **Pete Treinen and Dan Miller, owners of Village Mobil** donated the seat belts, as well donating and installing a new battery. **Greg Jensen of Ballweg Chevrolet in Middleton** donated four new tires, providing the balancing and installation of the tires, as well as a front-end alignment. **Dan Gleisner, owner of Super Lube**, provided a free oil change for the car.

**Michelle and her husband Robin** are the proud parents of five children. Although their family had a car, they were never able to all go somewhere together as their car didn't fit all seven of the family members. This new car not only provides the family with room to transport everyone, it also provides Michelle a way to get to her numerous doctor appointments, something critical to Michelle as she is a chronically ill cancer patient. "This car means so much to my family" said Michelle, "we now can actually get our whole family to events, and I can go to appointments without having to leave my husband without transportation". Recently Michelle had just arrived in Madison for a doctor appointment when the school called to notify her that her son was ill. Because she had their only vehicle, Michelle had to miss her appointment to pick up her ill child. "I can't express how this car, and all the other amazing things WNC has done for us has helped our family survive through these difficult years of illness and hard economic times. This car will change our lives, allowing us to be a whole family, ensuring I get to appointments, and allowing us to get to jobs."

"Today is a day that not only WNC but the whole community can be proud of", says **Genna Eaton, WNC's Executive Director**. "Today we are reminded that we have those in our community that don't have things that we just take for granted, like being able to have your whole family go somewhere together. We are so honored to be in a community that reaches out to help those who are less fortunate. **I want to thank our generous community member for donating this car, and to all of the wonderful businesses that partnered with us to make this day happen. ## Colleen's Contemplations

Questions and answers, aren't they supposed to go together? Do they ever really? I've had an almost constant headache for going on 5 weeks now. With medications of all kinds I've had a few moments here and there without pain, but for the most part, it's always there. Maybe once we get the pain to go away we'll be able to figure out what caused it. Maybe. Maybe we'll never know.

Life doesn't have a lot of certainty. There aren't any guarantees or warranties. "You get what you get and you don't throw a fit."--they say in kindergarten. I don't handle uncertainty well. I like to know exactly how much money is in the account and which bills come out when. I like to know that my children are safe and where they are supposed to be. I like to know that there are plenty of things to eat in the fridge even if most of them are considered yucky by the 10 and under crowd. I like knowing the answers, even if the answers aren't great. I'm very blessed. I have a lot of good things in my life. Not everyone does. Many do not know the things I listed above. Many have pains and illnesses that come with uncertainties greater than a headache.

Last week I had a CT scan done; it was disproportionately scary for the 5 minutes of actual activity. I was scared from the moment it was suggested until 26 hours later when my doctor called to say the results were fine. Uncertainty combined with waiting. I guess I'm writing about this because it has served to remind me how rare and precious any certainties at all are. We aren't guaranteed life, liberty or happiness, not really. Even faith isn't easy, despite the certainty you can have. There are still plenty of questions. And questions without ready answers are hard to sit with. Uncertainty, it messes with your head and your health and your spirit. But it's a very real part of life. I pray we get all the answers we're looking for, the patience to wait when we need to, and the faith to accept the answers.

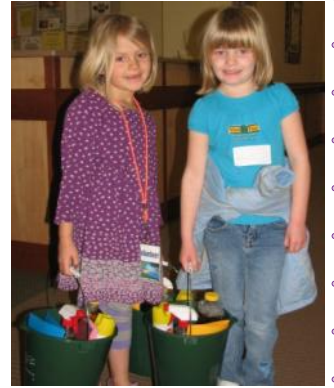
