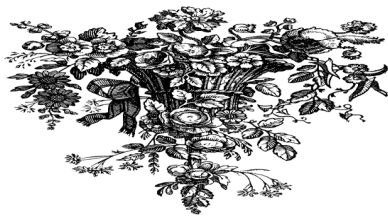

Be sure to stop by the store during the month of July to pick up your summer fun goodies.



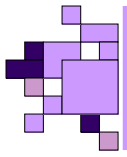

Hello to returning friends and new friends alike!

Waunakee Neighborhood Connection wants to be of service to all of you. As in past years, we will be open to you once a month to receive, free of charge, clothing, diapers, laundry soap, and whatever else we may have received from donors. We will do our best to find other items your family might need, like furniture, appliances, and miscellaneous household items. To do this we **need** to have current contact information for each of you.

This year we are trying a new way of registering clients and giving out some of the harder to get items. We plan to give each family vouchers to turn in for items like laundry soap, toiletries, and diapers. For instance, each family would receive 6 vouchers for laundry soap. You can still get soap every other month, just as before, but this way you also have more flexibility to pick up items you need **when** you need them.

To implement this new program we are having a
MANDATORY registration meeting on **Monday August 25th**
Location: The WNC store at 1001 Arboretum drive **at 9am** and again **at 6pm**.
One member of your family **MUST** attend this meeting.
We will explain any changes, distribute your vouchers
And make sure we have current contact information and birthdates.

If you are new to our program, we have a welcome to the community basket for you and more information about how our free store works. We have several programs for you to sign up for. In addition to shopping once a month, we have a birthday gift program. During the month of your birthday (or child's birthday) you may peruse our bins of donated gifts to find a treat for yourself or your child. It's just one of the ways we try to help every one of you feel special and appreciated.

We're looking forward to seeing all of you on the 25th!

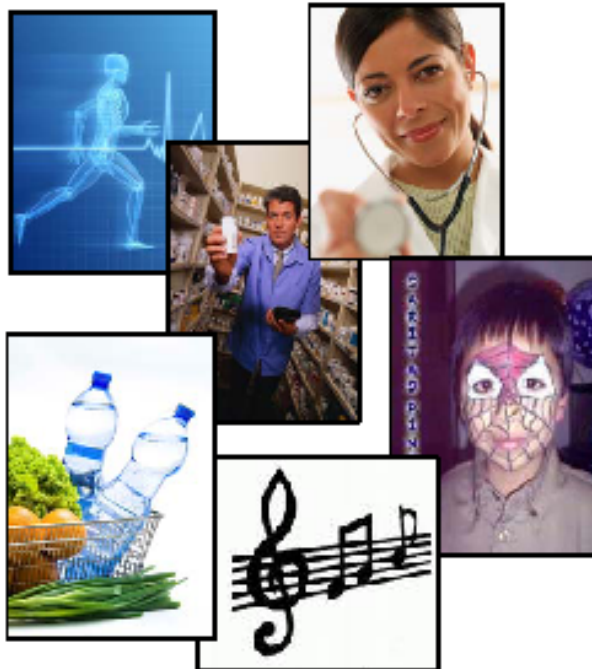

Free Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Available

Need your yearly mammogram or cervical cancer screening? No health insurance, high deductible, or your insurance does not cover mammograms? Wisconsin Well Woman Program provides free health screenings to income eligible women. This is an ongoing program that has been in Wisconsin since 1994. Over 25 medical clinics in Dane County participate.

There is a 1 in 8 chance that a woman will be diagnosed with breast cancer in her lifetime. All women are at risk for breast cancer, not just those with a family history. The good news is that breast cancer is treatable. Finding breast cancer early gives a woman a much greater chance of full recovery.
