Grants for School!

New grants are available for low-wage earners to help pay for technical college classes in the fall.

Gov. Jim Doyle announced a total of \$1.5 million in grant money. The \$1,000 grants are available to workers with no education beyond high school whose household income is currently less than \$29,140 for a family of two.

The money can be used for tuition, fees, books and supplies. Eligible areas of study are those identified as being high-demand occupations, including health care, biotechnology and energy.

In addition to the grants, up to \$250 per applicant is available to pay for the cost of tools and uniforms, exam fees, transportation and child care.
